How to Collect Badges

Accreditation procedures and badge collection

- Accreditation cards can be picked up by media representatives at any of the seven Accreditation Centers by presenting a valid passport/identification card (for local media representatives).
- Each participant varies responsibility for his/her accreditation card
- The accreditation pass is reflecting the permitted venues & zones during the event
- Each participant varies responsibility for his/her accreditation card
- The accreditation passes and the rights attached to it are personal to the party named hereon Organizing Committee, is non-transferable and must be clearly displayed at all times
- Photographing, Posting and/or Sharing Images of any accreditation pass online or via social media is strictly prohibited
- Accreditation cards which are damaged in such a way that the photograph and/or the personal information is not legible or that the access control system is not able to read the card, should also be returned for replacement at any accreditation facility that provides accreditation card printing
- Lost and stolen accreditation cards should be reported immediately to the nearest accreditation center or notified through email to security@cisgames2025.az

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Each venue will have a designated Media Meeting Point to support coordination of media activities on site. Clear signage will guide media representatives to the meeting point upon arrival. At each Media Meeting Point, a representative from the CIS Organizing Committee's Media Team will be present to assist with any inquiries and provide guidance inside the venue.

SERVICES PROVIDED AT MEDIA MEETING POINT:

- Photo bib distribution (for accredited photographers) for access to Field of Play

ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

Upon arrival photographers must check in at Accreditation desk in host city with valid ID. After verification they will receive an accreditation card.

PHOTO BIBS

Photo bibs are distributed in Media Meeting Points at the venue. All photographers should wear bibs in order to access photo positions. All bibs should be returned Media Meeting Points at the end of the competition.

ACCESS CONTROL

Only accredited photographers are allowed into media-designated zones.

DESIGNATED AREAS

Photography is permitted only from approved locations.

MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS

Movement between zones is regulated. No crossing into restricted areas during live competition

EQUIPMENT RULES

Gear may be inspected. Use only authorized equipment in field zones.

All photographers should wear photographer bibs in order to access photo positions in FOP. Photo bibs are distributed in Media Meeting Points at the venue. All bibs should be returned Media Meeting Points at the end of the competition.

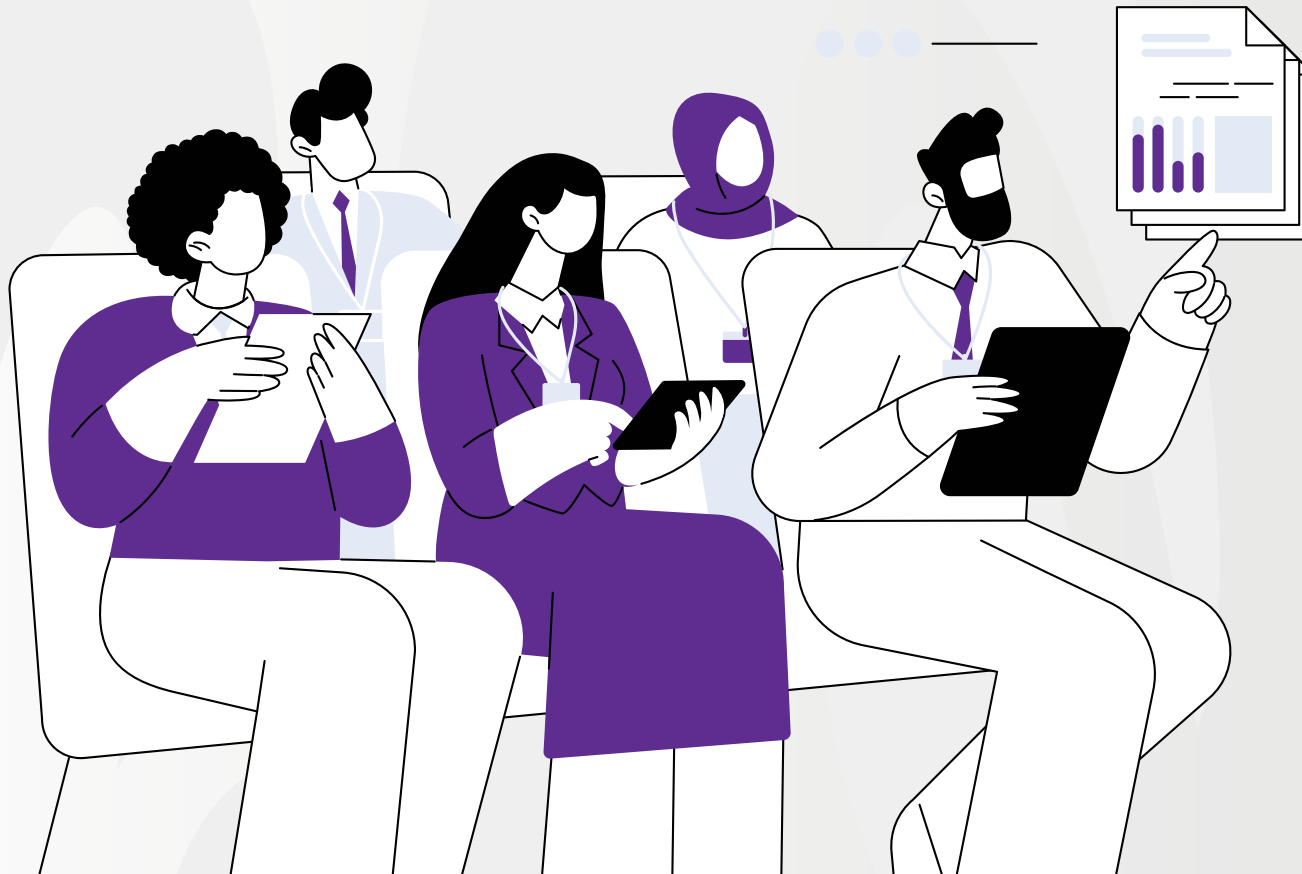
Photography is permitted only from approved locations. Movement between zones is regulated. Photographers should use routes dedicated to media. Use of flash in the venues is strictly prohibited. Flickr will serve as the official photo sharing platform. All accredited users will have access to the platform to download the latest photos from the competitions. All photographers are required to adhere to the instructions issued by the media team."



Mixed Zone Interview Procedures

There will be Media Meeting Points inside all venues, clearly indicated with signage and roll-up banners. A Media Operations team representative will be stationed at each table to assist. Registration for Mixed Zones will take place at these points.

Once a media representative is registered, they will receive a complimentary badge labeled "Mixed Zone Access." A Media Volunteer will then escort the media representative to the Mixed Zone.

There are two hubs: Naftalan and Shaki.

From the Naftalan hub, media representatives will travel to Ganja, Goygol, Mingachevir, and Yevlakh.

Travel Time from the Naftalan Hub to the host cities:

Naftalan - Ganja : 65 mins

Naftalan - Goygol : 60 mins

Naftalan - Mingachevir : 45 mins

Naftalan - Yevlakh: 40 mins

Those based at the Shaki hub will travel to Shaki and Gabala.

Shaki - Gabala: 90 mins

Khankendi Shuttle Services: The shuttle service will be on demand and will provide scheduled services for media representatives from Naftalan Hub and Ganja (Media Center).

Also, it will provide scheduled shuttle services from Ganja Media Center to the other host cities:

Ganja--> Mingachevir--> Yevlakh: Travel Time 1 hour 50 mins

Ganja--> Shaki --> Gabala: Travel Time 3 hours 15 mins

Host City Venue Shuttles: Host City Mobility will be provided by dedicated Host City Media Shuttles, facilitating seamless travel between host city event venues located in Ganja, Gabala, and Shaki. Host City Venue Media Shuttles will operate on a scheduled loop, ensuring regular and reliable transport between venues throughout the day.

Host City Shuttle travel time between venues: Maximum 20 mins.

Frequency: Every 30 minutes, shuttles will loop between host city venues.

There will be refreshment tables in all Press Rooms and the Media Center. Contents of refreshment table: refrigerator, serving table, water boiler, still water, tea bags, milk, instant coffee, sugar, stirrers, disposable cups, and napkins. These stations will be available throughout the day.

Hot meals will be provided at Ganja Sports Palace during lunch and/or dinner hours, depending on the competition schedule.

Banks and credit cards

There are a multitude of ATM machines located around Baku, most of which accept international debit and credit cards. Larger bank branches are open Mondays to Fridays (shorter day) but are closed on Saturdays and Sundays. International credit and debit cards are accepted in most restaurants and larger shops.



Currency

The national currency is the Azerbaijani Manat (AZN). One hundred Gepik (coins) equals one Manat, and Manat notes come in 1, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 denominations. It is not possible to exchange currency into Manat in countries other than Azerbaijan, so visitors will need to use the foreign exchange desk at the arrivals hall at the airport or withdraw from ATMs around the city.



Electricity

Standard electrical power in Azerbaijan is 220v. Electrical equipment and appliances use the standard European 220-240v two-pin plug.



Gratuities and tipping

Tipping is not expected across Azerbaijan but is common in Baku. Occasionally a service charge is included on the bill, particularly in more established hotels and restaurants. Like any other place in the world, tipping for above-average service will be appreciated.



Language

The official language is Azerbaijani but many people also speak Russian, Turkish and English.



General Opening Hours

Office hours are officially 09:00 to 18:00 Mondays through Fridays. Banks operate from 09:00 to 18:00, while service hours are from 09:30 to 17:00. Shops generally open around 09:30 or 10:00 and close around 20:00. Shops are open seven days a week. Bars and restaurants are open until at least 23:00.



Smoking

Smoking is permitted in public areas across Azerbaijan, including most restaurants and bars. Smoking will not be permitted in any III CIS GAMES venue, except for designated smoking areas.



Taxes (VAT)

VAT in Azerbaijan is similar to that in most European VAT systems, with tax levied on the supply of most goods and services and on the import of goods. VAT payers are entitled to recover the amount of VAT paid on purchases (input VAT) that exceeds the VAT received from their taxable supplies (output VAT).

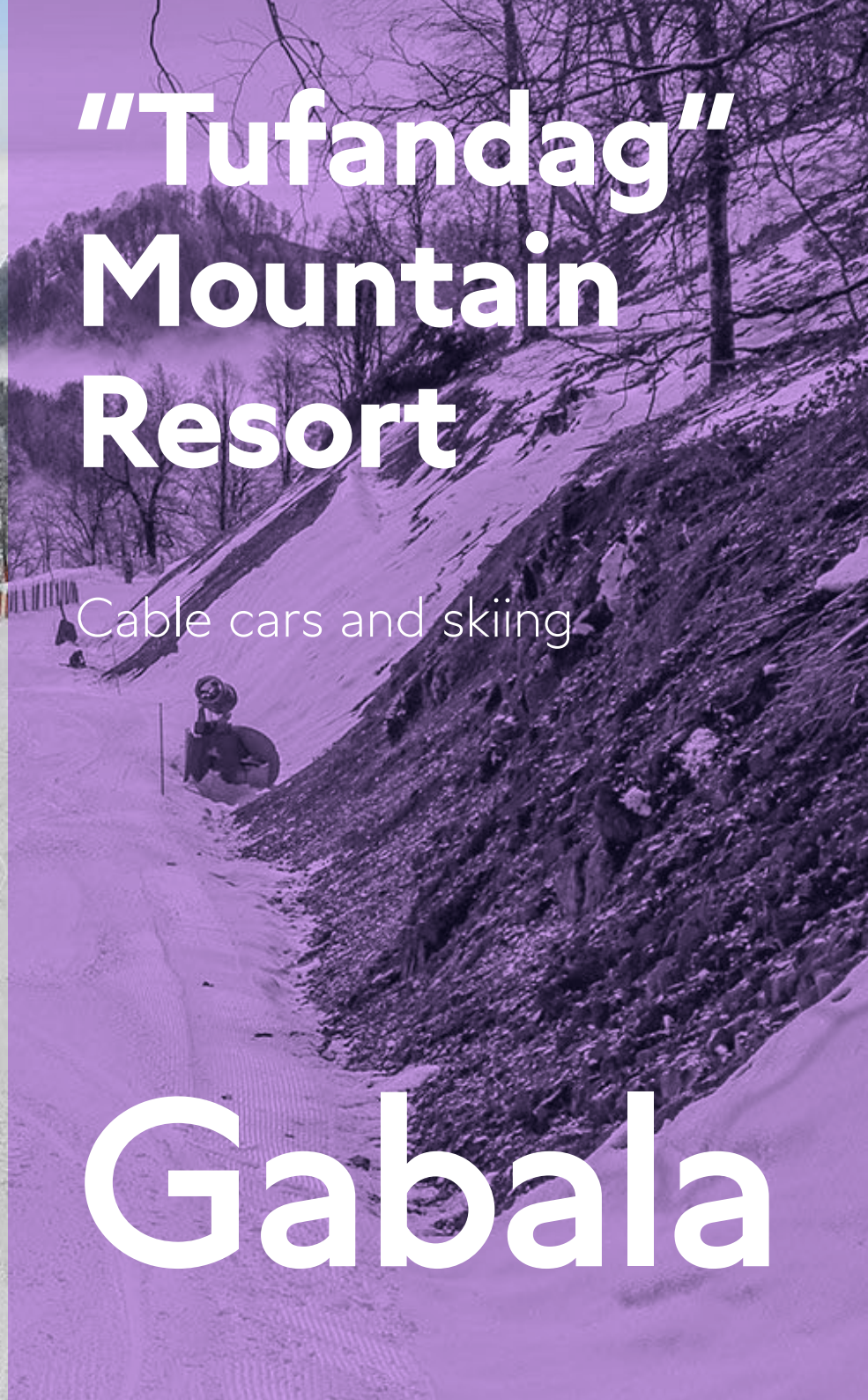



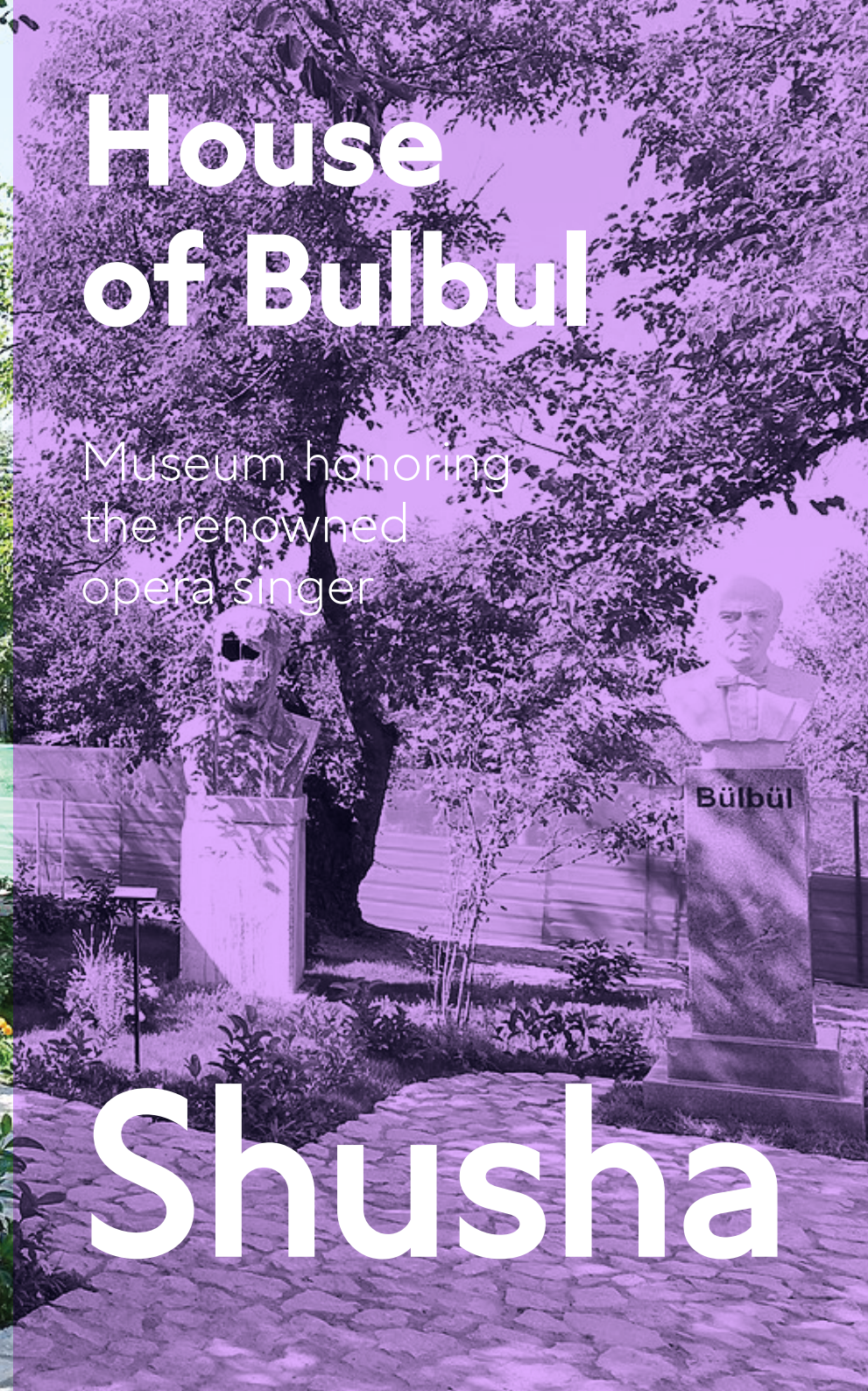

Dolma making and sharing tradition

**Inscribed: 2017
(shared with Türkiye)**

About: The preparation of dolma — grape leaves, vegetables, or cabbage stuffed with minced meat, rice, herbs, and spices — is a symbol of hospitality and family gatherings. It's usually prepared together by family members or communities.

Lavash: traditional flatbread making and sharing culture

Inscribed: 2016
(shared with Iran)

About: Lavash is a traditional soft, thin flatbread, part of everyday meals and ritual ceremonies like weddings. In Azerbaijan, it's baked in tandir ovens and often made by a group of women.



Culture of Pahlavə (Pakhlava) & Novruz

Novruz itself is inscribed
(2009, extended in 2016)
as a multinational element
(shared with several countries).

Novruz traditions include
preparing symbolic sweets
like pakhlava (baklava) and
shekerbura, which are
essential parts of Azerbaijani
festive cuisine.
